So again there's no escaping in visiting both sites. The second location is just down the road. In total 15 breweries are attending this year representing 10 countries. We have over 140 beers that go from easy going session ales to powerful and complex. From very sweet to very sour. From refreshing light bitter to harsh and spicy. Beer & Food

You can get all kinds of snacks during the day and in the late afternoon and evening there are meals available. Food is only available inside and in front of the old mill.

Train information

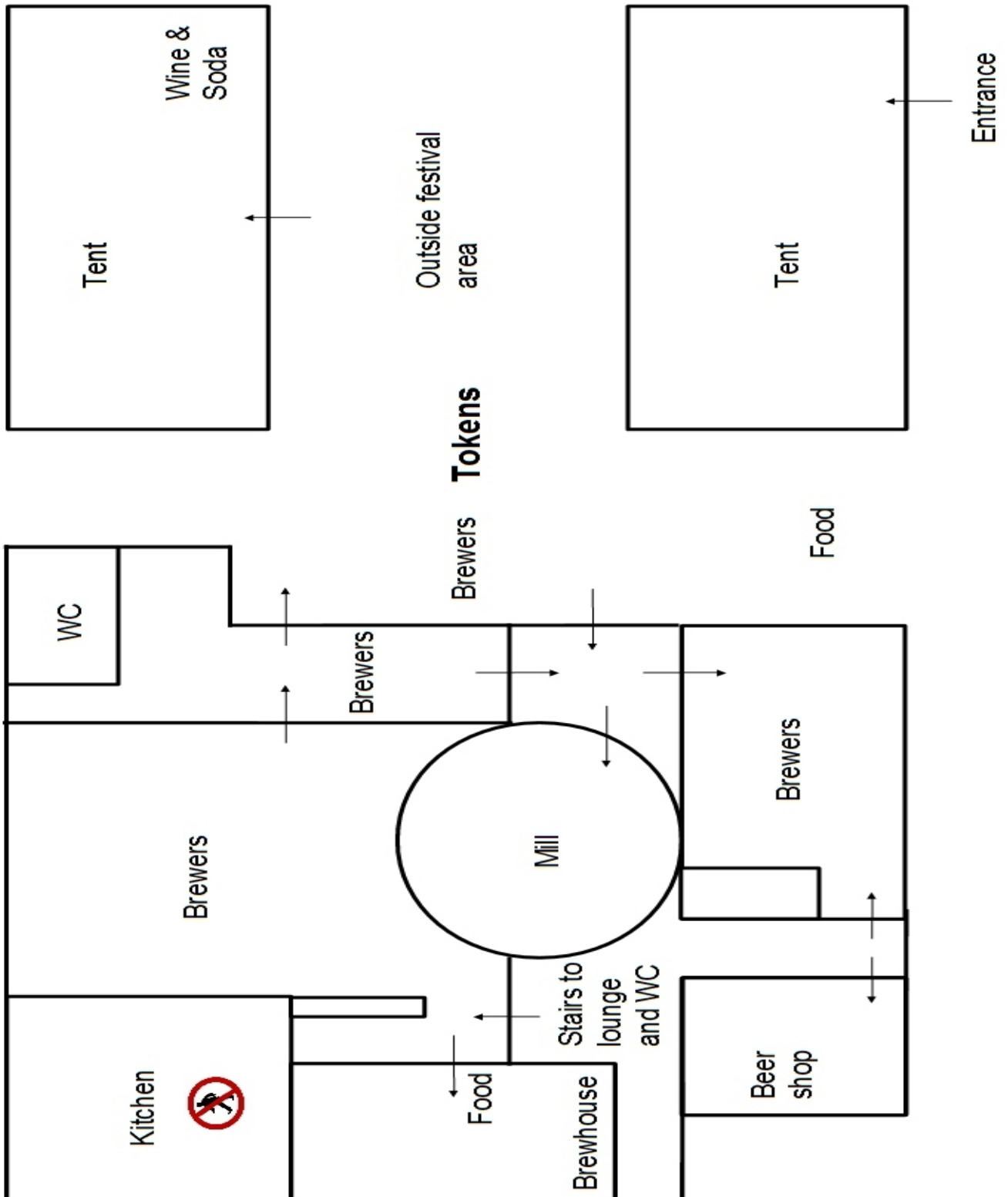
Leaving in the direction of Utrecht and Leiden:

Floor Plan of the Mill (Overtocht 43)

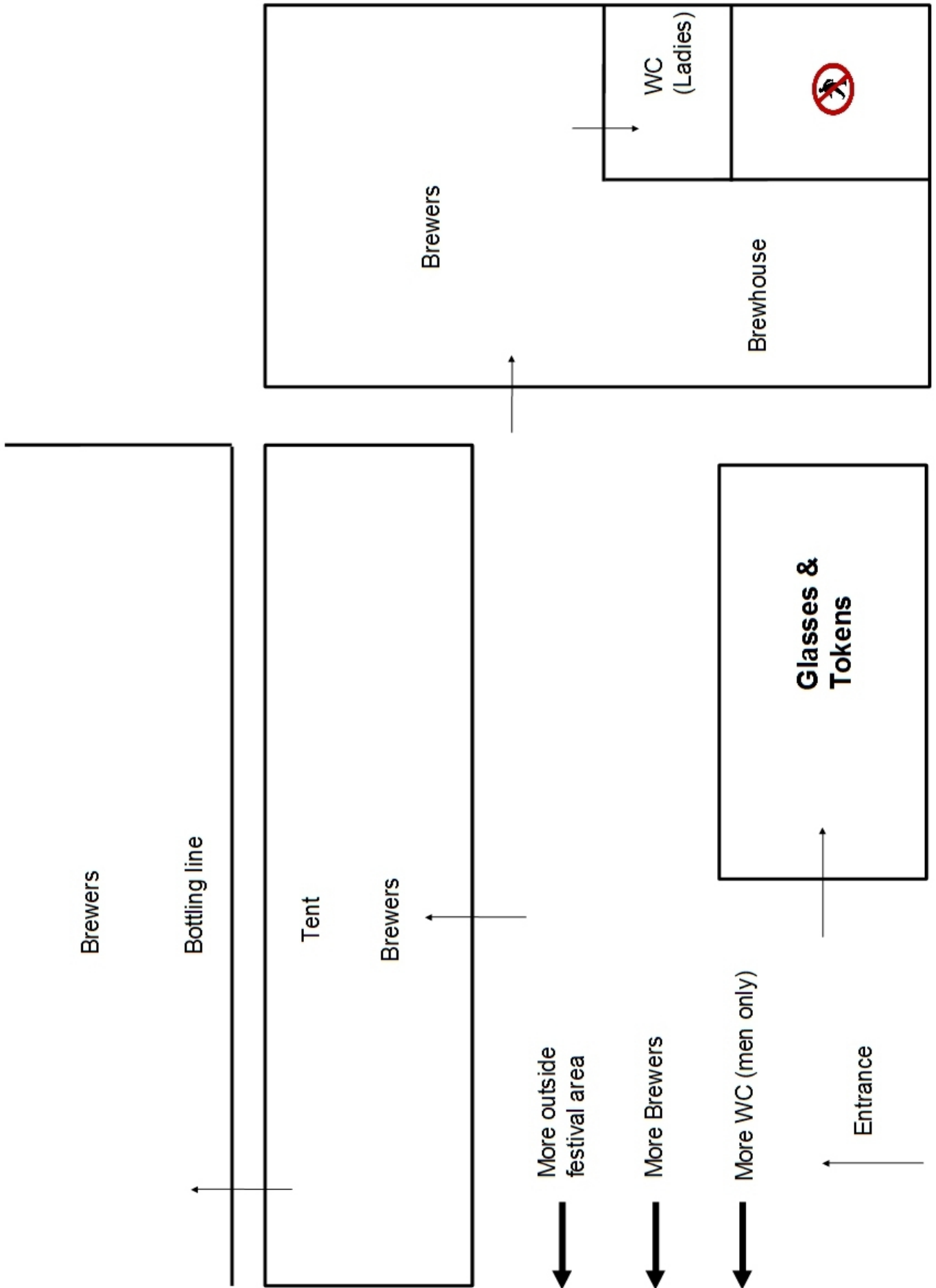
This is downstairs. There is an upstairs as well with lots of extra space to sit and also a WC.
